



## **MEMBERSHIP AND RACE CAR REGISTRATION APPLICATION AND RENEWAL PROCEDURE**

The WSWA membership year is the financial year i.e. July 1 to June 30 each year and the new applications and renewals should be completed in time for the first of the winter series events in July.

### ***PLEASE ALLOW SUFFICIENT TIME FOR PROCESSING AND POSTAGE.....minimum 2 weeks***

The membership and race car registration procedure is the same for new applications as renewals.

Daylight scrutineering is required each season and the machine examination will be accompanied by a

written test of racing rules as prescribed by the SCCA (Sprintcar Control Council of Australia)

Fees charged by WSWA will be forwarded to the SCCA for log book preparation and racing number registration. Another component of the fee will be forwarded to AWSR (Australian Wingless Sprint Racing) for national body membership.

### **STEP 1 WSWA Membership**

Download membership form from WSWA website, complete and forward to the secretary via mail or email with fee (\$80 for a driving member and \$30 for an associate member).

### **STEP 2 Speedway Australia license and insurance**

Download a Speedway Australia license application form and forward with the appropriate fee direct to Speedway Australia via mail or email.

***Note: A medical clearance is required each year as per SCCA rules.***

### **STEP 3 Race car registration and inspection**

Below is the list of registered Wingless Sprint WA Scrutineers you will need to contact to re-register your car for the 2011/2012 Season. After you contact one of the Club's Scrutineers and they "daylight" examination your Wingless Sprint they will forward your re-registration forms to the Club with Registration fee (\$400) to the Club Secretary. Alternately, contact the Club Secretary and arrange to Direct Deposit Car Registration fee prior to contacting a scrutineer. From advice being received by Club Secretary, the process will take 10 - 14 days to get a log book back.

You may arrange for the scrutineer to travel to your car for a reimbursement fee of \$50, whilst that fee will be a reduced \$20 charge if you take your car to the scrutineer. This fee is payable direct to the scrutineer.

*The scrutineer will require you to undergo a brief written test for your knowledge of racing rules. It will be an "open book" test of rules contained in the SCCA booklet which is issued by NASR with your license and NASR card.*
